

SUPPLIES for Painting, David Carlson

\*If the student already has supplies, it is fine to bring that as well

\*The student may choose either Drawing or Painting

1. Assorted Acrylic Paints:
  - Naphthol Crimson Red
  - Cadmium Red Medium (not hue)
  - Cadmium Yellow Medium (not hue)
  - Ultramarine Blue
  - Pthalo Blue
  - Pthalo Green
  - Diozanine Purple
  - Burnt Sienna
  - Burnt Umber (optional)
  - Titanium White (large tube)
  - Mars Black (large tube)
2. Assorted brushes:
  - ¼" flat and ½" flat, 1" brush
  - #4,#6,#8,#12 round
3. Palette knife
4. Containers for water (plastic yogurts work great)
5. 18" x 24" heavy white paper (Bristol is good, vellum finish)
6. Personal sketchbook with blank paper. (size up to you).
7. Stretched canvas starting week 2 and more (you can buy as you need).
8. Mediums, gel (gloss and matte) Golden has interesting mediums. Ex. GAC 100
9. Pencils, charcoal, pen
10. a small color wheel is good for color theory practice
